

## MEDICATIONS FREQUENTLY USED BY HOSPICE PROVIDERS FOR PAIN AND SYMPTOM MANAGEMENT

MEDICATION	HELPS TO RELIEVE	YOU MAY NOTICE
Morphine	Pain Shortness of breath	Sleepiness More shallow breathing Shorter periods of being awake
Ativan®	Anxiety Shortness of breath Nausea	Sleepiness Less restlessness Mild confusion Shorter periods of being awake
Haldol®	Nausea Agitation	Sleepiness Less restlessness Mild confusion
Dilaudid <sup>®</sup>	Pain Shortness of breath	Sleepiness More shallow breathing Shorter periods of being awake

ATIVAN = LORAZEPAM

## HALDOL = HALOPERIDOL

## DILAUDID = HYDROMORPHONE
